



- Presentations will be prerecorded and should not exceed 5 minutes in length.






- Once the video is uploaded to YouTube, please send the link to odga@odga.virginia.gov

DISQUALIFICATIONS

- The presentation indicates what organization, school, or agency the team is from.
- If a team submits a presentation after 12 PM on April 10th.
- If the audio does not work in the video or if it is so quiet that judges will not be able to hear the solution.
- If the video will not play properly or there is a technical issue that prevents the Datathon team from playing the video
- If the video audio is sped up (meaning the audio is playing at faster than normal speed).
- If the presentation is clearly a sales pitch for an organization or company.



